Residents' Council is a group of residents and/or their representatives who meet quarterly to discuss pertinent issues related to the nursing home. The residents are encouraged to attend meetings and discuss ideas and concerns. They are also encouraged to represent their peers when voicing opinions. The executive of the Council is elected annually by the residents.

The Residents' Council is established to provide a stong line of communication between the residents and administration with the hope of achieving many goals and providing suggestions on improving the quality of care.

The facility provides suitable accommodation and seating for meeting of the Residents' Council.
